

## CONSOLIDATED SCRUTINIZER'S REPORT

[Pursuant to Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 and Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 as amended)

To,

The Chairman of 46th Annual General Meeting ("AGM") of the Members of INDIAN BASE METALS COMPANY LTD. (the "Company") held on Friday, 15th September, 2017, at 03.00 p.m. at 34, Ganesh Chandra Avenue, Kolkata – 700013

I, Amber Ahmad, Practicing Company Secretary, have been appointed as the Scrutinizer by the Board of Directors of the Company, for the purpose of scrutinizing remote e-voting and voting through physical ballot process, in a fair and transparent manner and ascertaining the requisite majority on remote e-voting and voting through physical ballot process carried out as per provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act) read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules 2014, as amended, on the resolutions contained in the Notice for 46th Annual General Meeting of the members of the Company held on held on Friday, 15th September, 2017, at 03.00 p.m. at 34, Ganesh Chandra Avenue, Kolkata – 700013.

The Management of the Company is responsible to ensure the Compliance with the requirement of the Companies Act, 2013 and Rules relating to voting through electronic means (by remote e-voting) and voting by using physical ballot paper on the proposed resolution contained in the notice of 46th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the members of the Company. My responsibility as a Scrutinizer for the e-voting process including the remote e-voting and physical ballots is to ensure that the voting process is conducted in a fair and transparent manner and is restricted to making a Scrutinizer's Report on the votes cast in "favour" or "against" the resolutions, based on the reports generated from the e-voting system provided by Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL), the authorised agency to provide e-voting facilities engaged by the Company and the votes cast through physical ballot papers at the venue of AGM.



The Company has availed the e-voting facility offered by Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) for conducting remote e-Voting by the Shareholders of the Company. The AGM had also provided voting facility to the shareholders present at the meeting and who had not cast their vote earlier through remote e-voting facility.

The Shareholders of the company holding shares as on the "cut-off" date i.e. 8th September, 2017, were entitled to vote on the resolutions as contained in the Notice of the AGM.

The voting period for remote e-voting commenced on  $12^{th}$  September, 2017 (10:00 am) and ends on  $14^{th}$  September, 2017 (5:00 pm).

On 14th September, 2017, after the end of the remote e-voting period, I was provided access to the details of the members who had opted for the remote e-voting. The details such as the name of the member, folio no., and no. of shares held by the member could be seen to ensure that these members do not vote again at the AGM. However, the manner in which the votes were cast by the members was not available.

Further, the Chairman announced the Poll at the AGM for the shareholders who attended the meeting and had not cast their vote earlier through remote e – voting. Thereafter, one empty ballot box kept for polling was locked in my presence.

The locked ballot box was subsequently opened in the presence of two (2) witnesses who are not in employment of the Company. The Poll papers were diligently scrutinized and reconciled with the records maintained by Niche Technologies Pvt. Ltd., the Registrar and Transfer Agent (RTA) of the Company and the authorization / proxies lodged with the Company. There were no defective or incomplete poll papers received.

The votes cast through e- voting were unblocked after the AGM in presence of two (2) witnesses, who were not in employment of the Company. I have scrutinized and review the remote e-voting and vote tendered therein based on the data downloaded from the e-voting website of the CDSL and also the ballot forms received during the Poll process at the AGM.
